Respite visitors are perhaps living with long term health problems or have experienced a life crisis, but are not in a position to become a longer term resident. People in this situation are very welcome to make an application for occasional short, or one-off residential, visits.

Retreat visitors are welcome to come to Pilsdon at Malling to explore a vocation to community living or perhaps just to spend time in prayer and reflection in the context of a shared common life. Those who wish to spend time in silence may prefer to go to a retreat house specifically aimed at providing an atmosphere of silence and prayer.

For all visitors, we offer a brief stay within the community; an opportunity to relax and join our common life of prayer, hospitality and work. This may include opportunities to join in the day-to-day work in the gardens, with the animals or in the kitchen. We do not have a set price for a day / night, but ask you to donate what you feel you are able to give (for full board and lodging).

The Pilsdon at Malling Community is a dry house and the consumption of alcohol or illicit drugs on or off the premises is not allowed. Pilsdon at Malling is not a detoxification or treatment centre and does not accept people on methadone or similar prescriptions. Information that you give on this form will be treated as confidential unless it is clearly necessary to share it to protect your health and safety or the health and safety of others.
